DUE TO CHANGING LEVELS OF CONCERN AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTIVES THE JCCC'S COVID-19 RESPONSE HAS BEEN ELEVATED.

We share your concern about the COVID-19 (“coronavirus”) pandemic and have decided to temporarily close the Japanese Canadian Culture Centre to public access in line with Ontario public health directives. We are tentatively scheduled to reopen on April 7.
