

#### A NEW ERA

May 1, 2019 saw the close of the Heisei Era with the abdication of His Majesty Akihito, while July 9 will mark the 10th anniversary of Their Majesties' visit to the JCCC. We fondly recall their great warmth, humility, grace and kind words of encouragement. The JCCC wishes Their Majesties much happiness and comfort in their retirement.





The Heisei Era (1989-2019) was a time of great change. It was also a momentous time for the JCCC. The Era came into being shortly

after redress and the Canadian government's apology to the Japanese Canadians. At the time, the JCCC, in keeping with our motto of "Friendship Through Culture", was virtually bursting at the seams with activity and participation from both within the community and among our many friends. It was in that spirit that the centre took the decision purchase and build 6 Garamond Court, creating a new JCCC six times larger than our original facility at 123 Wynford Drive. It was a courageous step forward which, 20 years later, finds the JCCC internationally recognized as the largest and most vibrant centre of its kind in the world. The era also saw the loss of many of the Issei and Nisei pioneers who imagined and built the Centre in the early 1960s. Today many Sansei, Yonsei and Shin-ijusha have stepped forward to lead and carry forward the rich legacy of those pioneers.

The Imperial Household has long had a strong connection to Canada through Princess Takamado and we hope that the new era brings continued affinity for Canada and our community. The new era has been named Reiwa, meaning "Beautiful Harmony" is a term taken from the Manyoshu, an eighth-century anthology of waka poetry. As the new Emperor Naruhito and Empress Masako take the throne, we wish them, our community, members and many friends much beautiful harmony in this exciting new age.

In the spirit of celebrating the 90th Anniversary of Canada-Japan diplomatic relations, The Japan Foundation, Toronto presents AGA-SHIO, a piano and Tsugaru-shamisen duo that blends the passionate energy of Japanese folk music together with contemporary music, creating an entirely new form of Japanese music. AGA-SHIO are Hiromitsu Agatsuma on the three stringed Tsugaru-shamisen, and Satoru Shionoya on Piano.

#### **About AGA-SHIO**

The two musicians met in 2004 and put out their first album AGA-SHIO in 2009. AGA-SHIO has toured across Japan and also around the globe to 13 countries in Europe and Africa.

#### **About the Artists**

**Hiromitsu Agatsuma** [Shamisen Player], began playing the Tsugaru-shamisen at age six. He had become a renowned performer in the traditional Japanese music scene even in his youth, and made his major debut in 2001. His first and sixth albums won the prestigious "Japan Gold Disk Award"; his second album was released in the United States in 2003, for which he made his first tour overseas. He has performed in Australia, Brazil, and Russia, as well as in various countries throughout Asia and Europe. Agatsuma has collaborated with numerous artists such as Marcus Miller and Herbie Hancock.

**Satoru Shionoya** [Pianist/Composer/Producer], studied music composition at Tokyo University of the Arts. As a student he started his 10 year career as the pianist of the Japanese salsa band Orquesta De La Luz (1986-1996). The group won the United Nations Peace Medal in 1993 and was a U.S. Grammy Award nominee in 1995. During this time, he performed with Tito Puente, Dave Valentin and Santana. While with the group he started working as a solo artist in 1993, and has released over 12 original albums to date. His musical activities are diverse, composing and arranging scores in a wide array of genres including jazz, pop, classical, big band and for full orchestras.

The two yatate which were recently donated to the JCCC did not come with brushes, although one still has remnants of the ink cotton in the bowl.

#### 65 Years of G&G Electronics

Turning 90 years old is quite an accomplishment but having a business that has been thriving for 65 years and three generations may be even more impressive. This is the story of G&G Electronics, a business that opened in

1954 by George Tsuyuki.

George came from a second-generation Japanese heritage and was interned with his family during the WWII. He was released as a young man and worked at the Kimberly Clark mill and earned the admiration of one of the head bosses. The boss, Mr. Gibbs, gave George the money needed to follow his vocation, electronics.

In the spring of 1954, he used his savings to rent a store front on Kingston Road and opened Lakeside TV and Repair. Geroge and his wife, Shiz, soon had their first son, Gary, and changed the business name to G&G Electronics.

With the arrival of Sony in Canada in 1955 and George being of Japanese descent, George was given the opportunity to become one of the first Sony dealers in Eastern Canada. George was also recognized by Akio Morita, founder of Sony Corporation for his exceptional expertise and vending of Sony products in Canada.

In the 1980s they left the handling of G&G to their son Gary. Gary and Cheryl were the major push for growth, bringing new brands to the store like Nakamichi, Blaupunkt, Panasonic and Bose. This whole dream was almost lost to fire in 1984 when the store was set

ablaze by an electrical fire. The Tsuyuki family was familiar with adversity and turned what could have been a tragedy into a positive by having one of their biggest sales at the time, the fire sale. This sale put G&G on the map as the place to get great deals, and family style service. They continued this momentum into the present day.

G&G Electronics has been a staple in the Scarborough area, donating thousands to community efforts from community groups like the Boys and Girls Club and several sport teams.

Competing in his first Pan Am Senior Championships, Shady continued his rise on the international scene

by capturing the gold medal in the -100kg division in convincing style by winning all his matches by ippon, including a spectacular uchimata throw against the defending Pan Am Champion Leonardo Goncalves of Brazil in the final.

Congratulations to Shady for his steady rise at the highest level of competition! Shady's tournament schedule includes the IJF Grand Prix in Hohhot, China in May, then at the inaugural IJF Grand Prix in Montreal in July before the World Championships that will be held in Tokyo in August.






