

Lesson content and format are customizable on a student by student basis.

This program is for students 18 years of age or older. Hiragana reading skills are a requirement.

Shady El Nahas prepares for the Tokyo Olympics

Last year, Shady El Nahas was poised to become the first JCCC Judo-Kai member to represent Canada at the Olympics. However, the pandemic put the sports world on hold, interrupting the Olympic qualifying process. To compete at the Olympics requires that athletes achieve a very high qualifying standard through competition results on the International Judo Federation (IJF) World Tour, and the Olympic judo competition is limited to approximately 30 competitors per weight category and only 1 qualifying athlete per country.

For Shady, the pandemic meant several months of no judo training then very limited training in small groups with the national team to prepare as well as possible. Since the IJF resumed Olympic qualification competitions last October, Shady won the bronze medal at the Budapest Grand Slam, the gold medal at the Pan American Championships in November, and the gold medal at the Tblisi Grand Slam in March.

There will be a World Championship in June in Budapest, the last chance to qualify and to secure a top 8 ranking and seeded position at the Olympic competition.

We can cheer for Shady when the Mens -100kg competition takes place at the Nippon Budokan on July 29, 2021!

SENIORS' SUPPER CLUB

While not a traditional Japanese dish, steamed pork is a dish many Nisei and their families sought when dining at Chinese restaurants. This recipe tastes great freshly made, as well as cold as a part of a picnic or in a bun as a sandwich filling.

Steamed Pork

Serves 2

Ingredients

1/2 lb ground pork 5 breakfast sausage 115 g (1/2 can) sliced water chestnuts, drained

1 green onion

2 tbsp shoyu

1 tbsp mirin

1 tbsp hoisin

1 tsp minced garlic

1 tsp grated, fresh ginger

Equipment

Cutting board
Vegetable knife
Medium mixing bowl
Small mixing bowl
Wooden spoon
Small microwavable bowl or pie plate
Plastic cling wrap
Spatula or flipper

Instructions

- 1. Dice water chestnut slices and set aside. Clean, trim and slice green onion and set aside.
- 2. Remove breakfast sausage meat from casings and place in medium mixing bowl. Add ground pork, water chestnuts, and green onion and combine well.
- 3. In a small bowl, combine shoyu, mirin, hoisin, garlic and ginger. Add to pork mixture and combine well.
- 4. Place pork mixture into a microwaveable bowl or glass pie plate and press into place.
- 5. Cover with plastic cling wrap and microwave on high for 3 minutes. Remove from microwave and remove plastic cling wrap. Using a plastic spatula or flipper, turn pork mixture over. Cover with a new piece of plastic cling wrap and microwave again on high for 3 minutes.
- 6. Using a meat thermometer, check that the temperature is at least 160 degrees Fahrenheit.

Storage and Reheating

- · Extra half can of water chestnuts should be placed into a storage container and refrigerated. Water chestnuts are a great addition to stirfrys. Simply add them in towards the end of your cooking.
- · Store any left over Steamed Pork in the refrigerator. Left over pork can be microwaved on medium for 1-2 minutes. It also makes great sandwiches!
- · You can make the pork mixture and freeze before cooking. (Double the recipe to use up the can of water chestnuts, then freeze half in a freezer bag.) Allow the frozen mixture to thaw overnight in the refrigerator, then cook as above.

There will be two phases to this launch: this May release and a second group of interviews will be available by August 2021. We hope you will enjoy diving into Sedai's rich collection of oral histories that pay tribute to the Japanese Canadian community. Click here to learn more.

Please join us for Podcast Episode 2 exploring The Traditional Japanese House. Special guest experts include James Heron and Eiri Ota, principal architect at UUfie Architecture and Design Studio.

Eiri Ota tells us that there are ambiguous boundaries in the traditional Japanese house - inside and outside boundaries are blurred and become one. The houses are less of an enclosure of walls and more of a layering of space (or "ma") that divides and opens with sliding panels. Japanese houses are modest on the exterior trying to fit in with the surroundings - different from western house exteriors that are designed to make a personal statement.

James Heron describes how he loves the engawa or verandah (a narrow strip of wood around the house) that opens on to the garden, a place for meditation, reflection and moon gazing. In addition, James tells us what to expect in a Japanese bathroom – the unique bathtub and toilet. It is quite a surprise!

血管性認知症:母ミツエの場合!

2009年2月1日まだ未明、日本に住む母ミツエは隣人に連れられて自宅へもどってきました。寝室から外へ出るような行動をなぜとったのか、全く覚えていませんでした。一緒に住む長男夫婦は認知症を疑って直ぐにかかりつけ医へ。MRI検査では脳に異常は認められませんでした。甥から知らせがあり、直ぐに電話すると、元気はないものの会話に支障はありませんでした。しかし、翌日に電話すると更に元気がなくなり、聴こえも悪くなったように感じました。日頃の母とは何かが異なりました!

突然に理由なく歩き廻ったことが認知症発症サインとは考えにくいし、母に重大な変化が起きていることは間違いありません。老年看護のプロとしての直感と言ったらいいでしょうか。まだ原因はわからないけれど、実際に状態を確認しようと帰国を決め、チケットを申し込みました。でも、搭乗できるのは2日後でした。フライトを待つ間にみのは2日後でした。カライトを待つ間にみのは立つことが出来なくなり、38℃の発熱を生じ、6日に救急車で入院。再度のMRI検査でくも膜下出血とわかりました!ピアソン空港を発つ直前にその知らせが届きました。私のいやな予感が当たってしまいました…。

集中治療室ICUでの面会は20分のみ。脳内変化と薬物治療によりうつらうつらしていましたが、声をかけると「はい」と返事し、両手とも力を入れて握り、両脚も動いており、四肢の麻痺はありません。しかし、これから1~2週間にどのように変化するかは予断を許さず、90歳の身体機能がどれだけもつのか心配でした。

一進一退を繰り返しながらも徐々に快方に向かいました。少しずつ会話ができるようになった12日に「お母さん、私がわかる?」と問うと、考えているが返事はありません。見舞いにやってきた次男の名前も出てきません。私たちが娘と息子とわかっているかどうかも?脳出血によって神経細胞の一部がダメージを受け、記憶障害が生じています。細胞がどの程度死滅したかによって後遺症としての認知機能レベルが決まります。回復過程を根気強く観察し、様々なリハビリテーションを試みようと思いました。早速、面会時に必ず「娘の英子が来ましたよ」と名前を告げることにしました。

15日に初めて目を開け、すこし微笑む表情をみせました。深夜から早朝に目が覚めているのか、夕方になるとウトウトして夕食摂取が進みません。意識がはっきりしない

ために口の中に食べ物が残り、お茶を飲むとムセます。18日には輸液量が半減したので、水分摂取と食事は更に重要です。面会時間は午後2時から8時のため、夕食介助をしっかりやりたいのに眠るようでは困ります。電解質と糖質を補充するゼリータイプの経口補水液を日中に飲ませる様に努力しました。しかし、20日になっても状況に変化は見られず、ムセることが多くなりました。昼夜逆転と微熱の原因(誤嚥性肺炎?)、水分・電解質不足によるリスク、脳の状態などについて主治医に説明を求めました。

「循環器系処方薬に含まれる安定剤が日中の活動を抑制していると考えられるので、朝と昼をはずして夜のみとしましょう。微熱が続き、水分補給も困難なようなので12時間輸液を始めます」「先生、脳の状態に変化はないとのことなので、嚥下状態が良くないのは長期臥床による首周囲の筋力低下と考えてよいでしょうか?」「そうですね。全体的に筋力低下しているので、家庭にもどるには相当のリハビリが必要でしょう」

面会した初日から「母の入院記」を刻々と書き留めていました。客観的な観察事項、母の反応(表情や言葉)、スタッフや医師の説明など。夜に自宅へ戻って読み返してみると、様々な気づきがあります。当日の状況を解釈・評価し、翌日の看護計画を立案しました。ただ一人の大切な人のために、医療者として養ってきた力を総結集したのです。

病院では沢山の患者を対象としており、本人や家族が望むような対応を受けられるとは言えません。こちらから主治医に説明を求めなければ、問題を明らかにし、時機を得た治療とケアに結びつけたかどうかは…?夜中の転落や転倒防止のために抑制帯使用、回復過程に見合った自立行動支援の不十分さ、意識の混乱や記憶障害へのケア不足など…はっきり言って、問題点を多々感じました。

「もし入院が長引けば、90歳の母がもつ残存能力や病気から回復してきた身体機能さえも維持できない」と判断し、ともかくも一刻も早く自宅へ連れて帰りたいと、看護計画を病院スタッフに報告し、実践できる(してもらえる)ように相談しました。とは言っても、差し出がましいと思われないように、とても骨の折れる心労の多い日々でした。母が退院する頃に私の体調が悪くなった原因です(ホントに!)。

母の体力は次第に回復しましたが、理学



療法士が「右を向いて、左を向いて」という指示にさ~と反応できず、動作もゆっくりです。情報伝達路が遮断され、脳からの指令がスムーズに伝わりにくいのです。また、身体の回復につれて精神状態が混乱する様になりました。自分がどこにいるかがわからずに不安が一気に高まったのです。繰り返します。毎日、帰宅する前にその日の訴え(不安)について大きな文字で説明書きを貼りました。別れを告げた後にそ~と病室を覗くと、母は何度もその紙を読んでいました。言いようのない彼女の不安が伝わってきて、涙ぐんだこともあります。

2月26日、「私の名前がわかる?」「そんなバカなこと言って!」…まだ私の名前は出てきません。ところが3月3日ひな祭りの日に写真を撮ろうとすると、お見舞いの花を指して「英ちゃん、そこに置いたらいいわ」と初めて名前を呼んでくれました(写真)。その瞬間の嬉しさは忘れられません!3月半ば、生まれ育った島をよく覚えているのに、現在の家や暮らしのことは混沌としていました。3月24日、歩行できるように自宅を整え、退院に漕ぎ着けました!

自宅では、家族に囲まれて精神状態は徐々に安定し、介助すればトイレへ歩いて行けるようにもなりました。入院が長期になれば、おむつの状態が長引き、トイレ歩行は実現したかどうか…入院記を読み返すたびに考えさせられます。

「リト(祖母)さんの寿命88歳を超える様に頑張ってね!そうしたら、私も母さんの寿命を越すと約束するから!」と、母によく話していたものです。1週間寝込んだだけで旅だった母は、健康寿命93歳5ヶ月を見事に実践しました。70歳となった今日この頃、その達成がいかに容易でないかをしみじみ感じています。でも、母との約束を守りたいですね。




